1. Contestants will fish as a two (2) person team from the same boat or single entrant. Contestants will choose their own partner and register as a team. Five (5) fish per team. 12-inch limit, exemptions card provided.
2. Safe boating will be observed at all times. Each contestant is required to wear a U.S. Coast Guard approved personal flotation device anytime the combustion engine is operating.
3. All bass caught alive in a conventional sporting manner. Only artificial lures may be used with the exception of pork trailers. Only one fishing rod may be used at a time. Trolling as a method of fishing is prohibited.
4. All contestants are required to follow high standards of sportsmanship, courtesy and conversation. Intoxication will be cause for immediate disqualification. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs will be allowed during tournament hours.
5. Contestants must stay in the boat together during tournament hours. No wading allowed.
6. Competing boats must stay a minimum of two (2) casting distances apart, unless allowed by the other boater to enter area.
7. Boat numbers will be assigned as entries are received. First come basis.
8. Boat safety check will be done at the ramp; running lights must be on, life vest per person and live well systems open.
9. Big bass will be determined by the weight of a single fish.
10. Late boats will be penalized one pound per minute, disqualification after 15 minutes.
11. Protests must be in writing and submitted to the tournament director within 15 minutes after weigh-in.
12. Small fish penalty loose big & little fish weight.
13. A .50 pound penalty will be assessed for each dead fish.
14. The tournament committee will determine ties.
15. Each team will provide their own boats for the event. No airboats will be allowed.
16. In case of a boat or motor failure, one team member may be brought in on another tournament boat, with each teams limit being separated at all times.
